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Meridian Medical Arts Charter High School (MMACHS) was established in the fall of 2003 as a public charter school that operates independently within the existing local school district. The education program is a **career & technical approach** to prepare students for post-secondary education and a career in the health sciences. Students have the option of enrolling in an **Associate of Science in Health Science**-the only one offered in Idaho to high school students. MMACHS is a four-year comprehensive public senior high school with a current co-educational enrollment of approximately 200 students. Meridian is ten miles from Boise which is the state capital.

COLLEGE ATTENDANCE
