Advanced Opportunities are available in all public high schools around the state. These opportunities include: Dual Credit, International Baccalaureate, Advanced Placement, and Career and Technical Education. These programs are implemented with the intention to assist students in making a smooth transition to their future career aspirations.

**FAST FORWARD PROGRAM FUNDING**

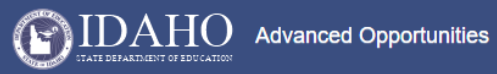
Often, students who choose to participate in these programs will encounter costs associated with college tuition, exam fees, etc. The Fast Forward program is available to assist students with these costs. Through the Fast Forward program, students in grades 7-12 who attend an Idaho public school have an allocation of \$4,125.00 to use towards the following activities:

1. Overload courses: High school classes that are in excess of their regular school day. Students can use up to \$225.00 towards the cost of each overload course. Definitions of full credit load may vary between districts and charters.
2. Dual credits: Courses that are transcribed on both the high school and college transcripts. Students can use up to \$75.00 toward the cost of each credit.
3. Examinations: Students can use funds to pay for college-credit bearing and professional certification exams. These include AP, IB, CLEP and PTE exams.

**Please note that all students utilizing Advanced Opportunities funds must have a [Participation Form](#) on file with their local school district.**

Students who plan to use this funding must work through their local school district. It is recommended that all students meet with their school counselor and have a learning plan in place before using these funds. Please contact your school with questions.
